

MARKET REPORT

June 19th, 2026

Seasonal transitions and weather continue to impact several growing regions, with tighter supply and higher pricing expected across select categories.



ASPARAGUS

More active as several growing regions finish for the season. Expect higher pricing over the next few weeks as supply tightens.



GREEN BEANS

Supply is improving out of Georgia, with northern growing regions expected to begin soon.



BLUEBERRIES

Michigan production expected to start by the end of the month. Pricing may remain elevated until new supply comes online.



BASIL

Supply and quality have improved, though mint quality remains affected by fumigation treatments.



MANGOES

Nicaraguan season is winding down while Mexican production continues.



CARROTS

Guatemalan baby orange, rainbow, and bi-color carrots continue showing excellent production levels.
