



MARKET REPORT

August 13th, 2026

Concern regarding the lack of rain in the central region. The asparagus market remains extremely active, with demand far exceeding supply, while baby zucchini production is excellent and promotional volume is available.



ASPARAGUS

Most production is currently coming from Northern Peru, which will remain the primary growing region through August.



GREEN BEANS

Bushel market is down, quality has improved.



BLUEBERRIES

British Columbia is winding down. Peruvian production is increasing slightly. Argentina should start after Labor Day. Markets are increasing.



Snow Peas

Supply of Guatemalan snow peas is limited because of reduced crop growth due to lack of rain.



MANGOES

Mexican production is ending. Brazilian production is a week away. Expect higher pricing.



CARROTS

Production of Guatemalan baby orange, baby rainbow, and baby bi-color is good. Improvement as of next week is expected.
