



MARKET REPORT

SEPTEMBER 21th, 2026

Asparagus remains extremely active, while limited rainfall in Guatemala is impacting production and quality. Some categories, including blueberries and new crop fingerlings, are beginning to show improving production.



ASPARAGUS

Demand continuing to exceed supply. Supply is expected to remain low, especially on bigger sizes, until Ica and Southern Baja production ramps up.



GREEN BEANS

The bushel market is steady with good quality.



BLUEBERRIES

Peruvian and Argentinean production is increasing. Markets are holding steady, but lower pricing is expected within the next 7 to 10 days.



Snow Peas

Supply of Guatemalan snow peas and sugar snaps is extremely limited. Markets are very active.



MANGOES

Brazilian production continues with higher pricing.



CARROTS

Production of Guatemalan baby orange, baby rainbow, and baby bi-color carrots is strong.
