

MARKET REPORT

December 5th, 2025

Overall produce conditions across Mexico, Central, and South America remain mixed, with improving supplies and quality in many categories despite lingering weatherrelated challenges and seasonal transitions affecting some regions and items.



ASPARAGUS

Mexico improving; Peru's northern output strong but southern slowing, shifting sizes smaller and standard.



BABY ZUCCHINI

Production continues to improve; weather recovery supporting gradual increase in overall availability.



BLUEBERRIES

Peru stable; Argentina season ending with Chilean harvest expected within two weeks.



CHILIES

East coast expanding, red fresno tight; orange habanero limited due to recent weather.



SNOW PEAS

Guatemalan volumes rebounding; Peru winding down season with low remaining output.



CHINESE EGGPLANT

Production up in Honduras; better weather improving quality and market consistency.
